

We ended up preparing and shipping 408 Operation Christmas Child gift boxes! Thanks to all who helped by donating items for the boxes, making the doll blankets and hacky sacks (some of our WOW gifts) sorting the donations, packing the boxes and financing this outreach.

Over 50 people helped pack the boxes at the packing party and enjoyed the hot dogs and walking tacos provided by Kendel. Special thanks to Jennifer and Nicole, the OCC project leaders, and Vickie Sampsel, Western Stark County OCC Coordinator. The December Mission Offering will go to the shipping fee of \$10 per box. The \$10 suggested donation for Operation Christmas Child (OCC) shoeboxes covers the costs of collecting, processing, and shipping the gifts to over 170 countries and the cost of ministry materials like The Greatest Gift Gospel Booklet and The Ministry Partner Guide. The boxes were taken to Calvary Baptist Church in Massillon, the first step on the journey to a young child's heart. Please keep in prayer safe travel for the boxes and for the children who will receive them and find the real meaning of Christmas, Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior!

We sang a song in November that tells my story "He Touched Me". In the spring of 2003 that is exactly what happened when I cried out "Jesus, if you exist, take my life". At that moment my life changed.

If you had asked me before then if I was a Christian, I would have said sure; knowing Jesus is the Son of GOD. Knowing that and actually knowing Christ Jesus and His freeing Grace are two totally different things.

GOD is Sovereign. At our original church I was honored to have been a facilitator of Stephen Ministry while Arbie facilitated Celebrate Recovery. Eventually we moved to another church where we found it impossible to get plugged in to any of their outreach programs. Then The Holy Spirit got hold of me. With His help we rescued my mom from a disastrous living situation, found a house, and took care of her. The congregation of the church showed Mom the love she had not experienced for some time. We stayed there until she passed away.

I then determined how Arbie and I would manage the rest of our financial lives together after we retired in 2017. GOD had a different plan... GOD is Sovereign... when MY plan went belly up, I finally committed to GOD's plan. In 35 days, our house sold, completely furnished, we purchased a truck, an RV, and we were off to New Mexico. GOD wants us to know His will for our lives.

After four years of service, sharing The Gospel, and NOMADing across the U S in approximately 20 locations, the LORD led us here, Living Grace Christian Church. We have had many opportunities here.

Giving Glory to GOD, Sharing The Good News, following The Will of GOD, are everlasting commitments that have become my life.


