

### Women's Study


Please make sure to join us every other Tuesday for our women's bible study! 18 and over please. Come join us any time, you don't have to have been with us from the start to join!

We had another great year for the St Pauly Used Clothing Shed!

- 18,236 pounds of clothing were donated to our shed in 2024.
- This was enough to clothe an estimated 3,359 people from all over the world.
  - Our church received \$729 for our effort.
- Donations not accepted at the shed, including such items as cook ware and home décor items, have been donated to the church's yard sale.

The St Pauly shed accepts all used clothing, shoes, belts, purses, blankets, sheets, pillowcases, curtains, and stuffed toys. **Sorry, no pillows!** Please place donations in plastic bags to help keep donations dry.

Why Donate?

- Reduce waste in landfills
- Clothing is used world wide
- Donations are tax deductable

For Operation Christmas Child in March we are suggesting personal hygiene products such as combs, toothbrushes, and wash cloths. No bars of soap or tooth paste please. Donations of toys, school supplies, craft kits, school supplies, coloring books, crayons, etc. are always accepted.

For the Fairless Food Cupboard we are suggesting baked beans and dish detergent. Any non perishable food items, cleaning supplies and personal hygiene products are always welcomed.

The 2025 mission trip to Oak Hill, WV has 10 volunteers going. The cost is \$250 for each volunteer and donations are accepted to help pay their fees.

### Faith for the Next Chapter

I am quickly approaching the empty nest chapter. Last weekend we took Charlee on a college visitation and watching her eyes fill with excitement as she gets ready to enter her next chapter in life was bittersweet. I quickly self-corrected and reminded myself that our awesome God has plans for us," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper us and not to harm us, plans to give us hope and a future, Jeremiah 29:11. This verse assures me that God holds my family in his hands during all chapters of our lives.

The world is getting scarier every day, and we are promised by prophecy it will only get worse. Sometimes it is hard to find the light when I am slapped in the face with this reality. Launching my children into a world so different in so many ways than the one I was launched into gives me a pause. But I know my God has created each of my children to be exactly in the time and place he wants them. He placed them in my care for only a short while and I know that for everywhere I have fallen short God will fill in the gaps.

As I am writing this my thoughts take me back to when we dropped Ruger off in Florida. It took a lot of prayer, faith, and trust in the Lord to leave him there. The first Sunday we went to Church without him, tears streamed down my face as I signed the pew pad without his name. Our little family had changed. I am so grateful that God has brought him home safe and he is now making his own place in this world. I know that our God will use him in great ways to bring other to His glory.

I pray my next chapter finds me and Mike exploring new things and continuing to support our children in the ways that they need. Thankfully, God has provided me with an ever-present source of earthly strengthen in my husband, Mike. This fall the names on the pew pad will drop to just the two of us, and I am sure the tears will stream again. I thank God for those tears for they are a reflection of deep love. I know "thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path" (Psalm 119:105) and as my little family changes again I trust God will light our path.

To keep God's light ever present in my life I wear a cross as a constant reminder of who I belong to, for I am His. It is a symbol and a reminder of all that was done for me and a promise of what is to come. Every time I put it on, reach to adjust the clasp, take it off, or see its reflection in the mirror I am reminded of where I came from, where I have been, and where I am going. The cross I wear most often holds immense significance in my life. It was handmade for me after the passing of my dad. It is a replica of a cross found in my dad's barn by my brothers. The original was made of railroad ties. My father worked on the railroad. This cross is not just an accessory; it is a testament to my dad's faith and a beacon of hope that my dad knew our God. It reassured me during moments of doubt and strengthens my resolve to face the challenges ahead. Each time I touch it; I feel a sense of peace and connection to both my earthly father and my Heavenly Father. It is a daily affirmation of my identity and purpose grounding me in my beliefs and inspiring me to live a life of gratitude. Current anthem playing in my head by CeCe Winans, give it a listen.

Originally named the Christian Hall of Fame Youth Camp and Conference Center, the name was shortened to Camp CHOF (Christian Hall of Fame).

For many years, Camp CHOF has presented the gospel to young people in an environment free from distractions of the world. Not only does Camp CHOF provide an exciting summer camping program, but the campgrounds are also available to rent throughout the year.




