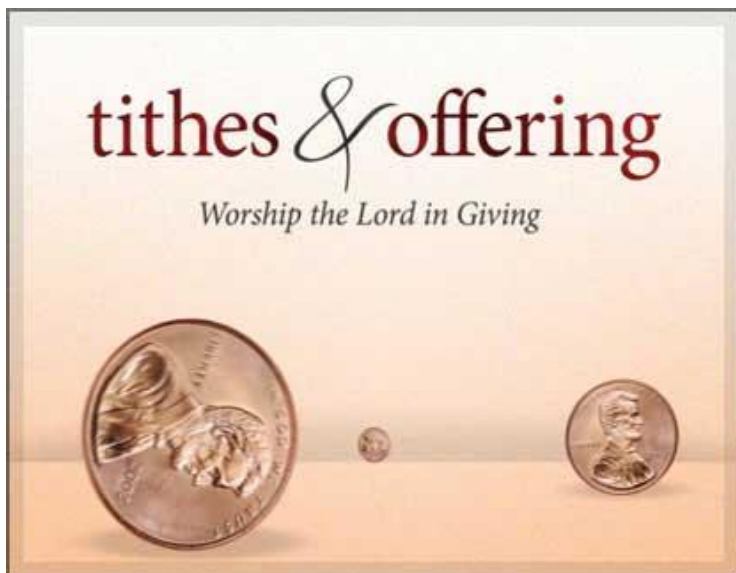

Items being brought in for Operation Christmas Child. If you aren't familiar with what OCC is, please see the attached flyer for info on how this amazing ministry works. Our church is heavily involved in this ministry and was able to pack over 400 boxes last year! We greatly appreciate your help! We also have a competition on what grades can bring in the most products. Each kid is welcome to bring in as many of these items as they wish to help their grade win for the day!

DAY 2 – Crayons, colored pencils, and coloring books

DAY 3 – Band-Aids, hairbrushes, toothbrushes, and wash cloths

DAY 4 – Flip Flops of any size

Day 5 – Stuffed animals (under 8in in size, must fit in a shoe box)

Children are encouraged to bring in a monetary offering every day. The money will be going to save animals in the Arctic. If you wish to see how we are going to "adopt/save" these animals. I have included our goal for the week of the animals we wish to successfully adopt on the back of this paper.

Parents are welcome to come up to the sanctuary when picking up their children from VBS each night to watch the closing.

Thank you to everyone who took time to be a part of our Christian Education Ministries this year! Our kid ministries have grown so much, we grew in numbers but most importantly, we grew in heart. Thank you to all of our Sunday School Teachers, Kidz Church Volunteers, everyone who helped with JOY Club/WNR and everything else in between. Thank you to Hannah Stacy who kicked off our first Women's Study! We will be on the lookout for a woman to facilitate a new study this fall. We already have so much planned and we are looking forward to everything to come next school year.

Please join us on June 15th, Father's Day Sunday for our Second Annual Father's Day Giveaway led by the Kidz Church Kidz.

I am currently looking for a person/people to lead the kids next year on Wednesdays (JOY Club)! This volunteer position will consist of following our JOY Club Curriculum and being with the kids for an hour every Wednesday starting in September. There will be Thanksgiving & Christmas Breaks! Our Wednesday Night Reset Program will end around Easter. The curriculum consists of reading the bible story for the week, discussion questions, an occasional craft and games to end the night! It is all right there for you in the curriculum, there would only be prepping for the occasional crafts. Dear Congregation,

We hope this letter finds you well. You are all an important part of our church family, and we have so appreciated your support in the past, we thought you would want to know about our plans for future projects around the church.

As you may know, when we transitioned to the Global Methodist affiliation, we as a congregation took ownership of the real property and assets including the church property, parsonage and contents contained in them. As being good stewards of these items for future generations, we come to you with transparency and goals for all to work towards.

The trustee and finance committees have been working together on several major capital improvement projects around the church these past few years. However, these projects have taken a toll on the building fund which is now low in reserve. Some of the key projects completed include the two rooftop air conditioners, parking lot improvements, re-branding with the Global Methodist Church and other lesser assets such as copier, HVAC replacement and boiler repairs. All in, these projects have cost the church between \$80,000 and \$100,000.

Together, the two committees are working together to complete an Asset Management Plan. This is a proactive approach to estimate future projects that need to be completed in the coming years. Those projects include new roof(s), doors and windows around the church, boiler, elevator(s) replacements and technology upgrades. Our long-term goal would also be to upgrade the current restrooms on the main floor to allow better accessibility to our facility, replace windows in the Christian education wing and improved main entrance.

That said, we will be requesting contributions that will make these improvement projects possible, and we ask you to consider giving to support the future improvements around the church and parsonage. These contributions will be above the standard tithing which is critical to meeting our current annual budgetary goals.

Your pledge, no matter the size, will be greatly appreciated and put to good use. Our goal between July 1, 2025 and June 30, 2026, is to raise \$200,000. We invite you to be a part of this endeavor for the church and help us create a space where we can continue to worship, learn, and grow together.

If you would like to contribute to this cause, please fill out a pledge card and drop it into the offering plate on Sunday morning, please no names are required on the pledge card. When contributing to your pledge amount please make a note these contributions are for the "Building Fund or Capital Improvement Pledge".

Feel free to reach out to our finance chairman, Denese Majors, or trustee chairman, Matt Miller if you have any questions about our fundraising initiatives or past building fund expenditures.
